

Maysville is located on the Ohio River at the mouth of Limestone Creek. It occupies the narrow river plain and the steep hills rising from it, giving the city the dual presence of downtown and 'on the hill'. The city extends inland to the historic former town of Washington. The city itself has a total area of about 20 square miles.

Maysville is served by two bridges connecting Kentucky and Ohio. The scenic Simon Kenton Memorial Bridge is a suspension bridge built in 1931. The William H. Harsha Bridge, a cable-stayed bridge, was completed in 2001.

Located 60 miles southeast of Cincinnati, OH and 70 miles northeast of Lexington, KY, Maysville is accessible by both four- and two-lane US and state highways. With a population over 17,000 in Mason County, everything you need is right here and anything else you might want is just a short, easy drive away.

Maysville was pivotal in the settlement of the Kentucky Bluegrass region. Founded in part by frontiersmen Simon Kenton and Daniel Boone, originally called Limestone Landing, Maysville was an important port for the northeastern section of

the state. Manufacturers located early in Maysville, exporting everything from hemp and tobacco to fancy ironwork. To this day, manufacturing remains an important part of the modern economy.

Buffalo used to cross the Ohio River at this place, beating a broad path into the interior of Kentucky in search of salt. Settlers traveling down the Ohio found a natural harbor at Limestone Creek, and the buffalo trace a natural path into the Bluegrass Region extending all the way to Lexington. The first settlement in the area was made by Simon Kenton in 1775.

In 1788, when Mason County was organized, Maysville was still a sparse collection of warehouses and wharves, with few dwellings. In 1795 the conclusion of the Northwest Indian War reduced the likelihood of Indian attacks from across the Ohio and allowed Maysville to flourish. By 1907, Maysville was one of two principal Ports in Kentucky.

Maysville was an important stop on the Underground Railroad with the free state of Ohio just across the river. Harriet Beecher Stowe visited the area in 1831 and witnessed a slave auction here. Stowe included the scene in her novel Uncle Tom's Cabin, published in 1852. Today, several museums in the Buffalo Trace region are dedicated to the memory of the abolition of slavery.

Prior to Kentucky's statehood, Maysville was part of Old Bourbon County, Virginia, where pioneer distillers discovered that the Indian corn and limestone water of the region made a product of mellow character and distinguished flavor.

Today, the bourbon-making tradition is carried forward by fifth and sixth generation Pogues using the original Poque recipes under a time-honored and fixed formula very near a site often said to be the location of Kentucky's first bourbon distillery.

Maysville has a rich history, spanning more than 240 years. With a pioneer village and numerous museums and historic buildings, Maysville continues to remember the past as well as embrace the future.

Not just a Home, a Community

Given its location and size, Maysville accommodates both town and country lifestyles. As one of the larger towns in the area, Maysville offers plenty of suburban housing and farmland, as well as riverfront properties. The downtown area features beautiful architecture as old buildings with classic looks are being renovated into new, upscale apartments, right along the river.

Maysville offers comfortable, affordable houses in all ranges of price, style and location from existing historic homes to new construction. A variety of neighborhoods, both in Maysville and Mason County, are available, including golf course communities, active senior communities, rural vistas for mini-farms, and spacious lots. Some neighborhoods boast views of the Ohio River, others offer a walkable neighborhood of historic homes.

When you combine low taxes, low utility costs, and low crime rates with proximity to area amenities, great schools, and a variety of entertainment choices, you get an outstanding community with hometown charm.

Maysville offers low property taxes compared to metropolitan areas, a feature that's hard to beat. Real estate tax per \$100 in the city of Maysville is just \$1.182 - or about \$1773 for a house valued at \$150,000. Some nearby metro areas compare at nearly double that.

In addition to permanent residences, a wide selection of rental properties are available. An often overlooked, but fantastic option is the historic downtown area. Recent renovations of historic second floors and availability of townhouses add a unique dimension in local housing.

Good sources of information on current rental properties and new home listings are available with local realty companies or online at www.usamls.net/buffalotrace. Real estate agencies are listed in the directory on page 48.

Maysville has a thriving arts scene. The local theatre troupe, the Maysville Players, frequently put on wonderful performances, both musicals and dramas, in the historic Washington Opera House. The Ohio River Valley Art Guild frequently presents art shows by local artists, and several retail galleries produce a variety of fine art.

We love a festival! Festivals occur all year round here. One of the bigger seasonal festivals is Maysville's Oktoberfest, which people travel from all cities and states to attend. People line up for schnitzel at the various vendors and food trucks set up all around the biergarten, while others sway to polka music on the dance floor.

The best part of living in a small town is the sense of community felt from having close relationships with friends and neighbors. Because people are continually moving into and out of Maysville, people make friends fast here. We are just far enough south to enjoy friendliness and hospitality with everyone, even if we've just met. Numerous community and civic organizations help improve the community while building relationships and networking.

Maysville is fortunate to have benefited from the hard work and generosity of these civic organizations. We have a large Boys & Girls Club which offers after school care, a summer camp, and year round sports leagues for young kids. We have one of the largest YMCAs for a town our size, as well as a great museum with both traveling exhibits and permanent installations. For those interested in volunteering or serving the community, there are many non-profit, emergency agencies, and churches of nearly every denomination in Maysville and Mason County.

The population of Maysville is mostly people 25 to 65, with school aged children. A small town

offers a sense of safety for families. This is the type of town where kids can still play outside at night in their neighborhoods, and ride their bikes to the community swimming pool at the Maysville Recreational Park.

Lots of outdoor activities abound here. It's a great location for cycling or running, with many gentle hills. Nearby there are also places to camp, canoe, kayak, and of course the river is great for boating. We have four golf courses ranging from the country club to a Par-3 course at the Maysville Recreational Park (Rec Park). The Rec Park also features miniature golf, a (recently renovated) community pool, an obstacle course for dogs, several playgrounds, shelter houses for picnicking, and a large fishing pond surrounded by a walking path. The Cummins Nature Preserve has many activities for kids, and groups to explore the woods through hiking trails. Along with these public spaces, several small community parks and playgrounds are tucked within neighborhoods.

Our two main schools - Mason County Public Schools, and St. Patrick Catholic Schools - offer a great education with many extra curricular activities. A variety of sports for both girls and boys are available at both schools, and both schools produce theater productions each year. Mason County schools also have a large music program for voice and instruments.

Maysville is a small town, but it's no sleepy little thing. With new, trendy businesses and restaurants opening all the time and beautiful downtown festivals and parades, it always has something to offer. Whether you've lived here your whole life, or are new to the area, this lively town ensures that there's always something going on, and always new memories to be made.

Maysville offers excellent options for public and private education from preschool to high school. Both options offer college prep courses, dual credit, and a variety of sports and fine arts activities. In addition, we have a regional campus of the Kentucky

Community & Technical College System. Top education and extra-curricular experiences are readily available and affordable.

The Mason County School System is a consolidated school serving all of Mason County. The campus is split in two locations: one campus houses Straub Elementary School (grades preschool through 2), Mason County Middle School (grades 6-8) and Mason County High School (grades 9-12). The second campus is home to Mason County Intermediate School (grades 3-5) with the STEAM Academy just across the street. Both campuses are served by the Mason County Youth Service Center and the Mason County Family Resource Center,

agencies that help students of all ages and their families prepare and succeed in their education.

Mason County was the first K-12 Project Lead the Way district in the state of Kentucky. Project Lead the Way emphasized science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM). The STEAM Academy is a state-of-the art facility serving engineering, computer science, bio-medical, agriculture and aerospace students. A new barn was constructed which allows students to carry on the rich agriculture heritage of our region while preparing for 21st century job opportunities in agriculture. Opportunities for high school students have expanded to also include the choice to focus on the arts, business, education, culinary arts, aerospace, computer science, career tech education, and/or early college opportunities through partnerships with MCTC and Morehead State University. Their Ron Clark Classrooms continue to expand, providing high energy,

high engagement instruction to students in every building. The Royal Diploma (graduate profile) assures each student in grades K-12 not only excels academically but also demonstrates the soft skills employers are seeking. More information is available at www.masoncoschools.com.

Mason County Area Technology Center offers high school students training and industry certifications in: Automotive Technology - Maintenance, light repair and automotive service technician training. Computerized Manufacturing and Machining - Fundamentals of machining, both milling and metal lathe. Electrical Technology - Entry level Electrician preparation (construction/manufacturing). Health Sciences - Preparation/completion for State Registered Nurse Aid. Welding Technology - Preparation for welding careers, students can earn 3G and or 4G AWS welding certification.

Carmeuse-Mason County Indoor Athletic Center is not only home to Mason County's prestigious STEAM Academy; it also houses the only high school indoor track facility in the state of Kentucky. With 8 straights and 4 oval lanes, a polyurethane rubber surface track, an inground horizontal jumping pit, indoor shot put and indoor high jump, the facility has hosted the middle and high school indoor state track championship since 2014.

Saint Patrick School is a Catholic school providing Christ-centered education since 1860 for preschool through 12th grade. HEALTH & WELLNESS



The Maysville-Mason

County region offers top of the line health care in a broad area of specializations. There is no worry that moving to a town big on charm will be small on professional care. Large and small practices and specializations include family medicine, pediatrics, orthopedics, foot care, optometry, dental, gastroenterology, internal medicine and even veterinary care for man's best friend! Also available are two area dialysis clinics and a cancer treatment center. Long term care is available at Maysville Nursing and Rehab Center or through one of several home health care providers. Services to our aging population such as congregate and home-delivered meals are provided by the Mason County Senior Center. Access to effective crisis intervention is provided at the Women's Crisis Center.

The **Buffalo Trace District Health Department** (BTDHD) leads and empowers communities and individuals to achieve better health. Through its offices in Mason County (Maysville) and Robertson County (Mt. Olivet), the health department provides a wide array of services, from vaccinations and school physicals to

free fitness classes, one-on-one nutrition counseling, and car-seat installations. Teams dedicated to clinical health, environmental health, health education and health promotion, and disaster preparedness work together to create a healthy community for everyone. BTDHD also administers the WIC program and the Health Access Nurturing Development Services (HANDS) program for Mason and Robertson Counties, and hosts the Mason County Health Coalition, a partnership of community members who want to "create a culture of health" in our region through a wide variety of activities.



Rate, Educational Attainment, including those with some college and those with higher degrees, decreasing the number of those who do not have a high school diploma, Community Support, those who hold the Kentucky Essential Skills Certificate or a Career Readiness Certificates, availability of internet, and available apprenticeships. The application also includes narratives describing what the county is doing to meet Workforce Supply vs. Demand and how the Disabled, Veteran, Ex-Offender and Medicaid populations are engaged in locating employment.

The Maysville-Mason County Area Chamber of Commerce continues to lead the County in achieving the goals needed for recertification.

Another important program in the region is **Leadership Horizons, Inc.** Recognizing that leadership development is an essential element in the process of workforce development; the

program was created by the Maysville-Mason Co. Area and Fleming County Chambers of Commerce in 1997. The sessions assist participants in developing an awareness of the assets and strengths as well as problems and challenges faced in the region. Leadership Horizons provides an opportunity for participants to network and develop contacts that can assist them, both personally and professionally, in becoming a strong, positive influence on the future of our local communities and the region. Participants meet one day a month, September through May, to discover what the area offers in various areas such as Tourism and Recreation, Education, Media, Health and Human Services, State Government (a trip to the capitol in Frankfort, KY to meet with legislators), Economic Development, Agri-Business and Law & Justice. The program is administered and organized by the graduates of the program with oversight from the Maysville Chamber.

TRANSPORTATION



Thanks to Maysville's central location in the United States, transportation is both economical and available via highway, rail and river.

Highways

U.S. Highways 62 and 68, Kentucky Routes 8, 10, 11, and Kentucky 9 (AA Highway, a Super 2 highway) are all "AAA" rated trucking highways (80,000 pound gross load limit). Both provide easy access to several interstate highways including I-64 and I-75 to the south/southeast and I-71, I-74 and I-75 to the northwest.

Maysville has the advantage to be connected to Ohio by two bridges, the Simon Kenton Memorial Bridge and the William Harsha Bridge.

Fleming-Mason Airport (6 miles south of Maysville) - 5,000 ft. lighted runway with GPS & localizer approaches, full length taxiway with T-hangars

Bluegrass Airport - Lexington, Kentucky (71 miles southwest of Maysville)

Greater Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky International Airport - Hebron, Kentucky (72 miles northwest of Maysville)

Rail

Passenger rail service is available via Amtrak both to and from Maysville. CSX Transportation provides freight transportation for the area via a Class 1 Railway line.

River

In 2015, Mason County joined The Ports of Cincinnati & Northern Kentucky which formed an inland port jurisdiction that includes 226.5 miles of commercially navigable waterways of the Ohio River and Licking River in Kentucky. It is comprised of 15 counties in Ohio and Kentucky and is the busiest inland port in the nation.

Local Transportation

Maysville has a public transportation system which runs within the city limits. Children and senior citizens may ride free of charge while students are just \$.15 and adults \$.25. The city also operates a handicap van, which complements the public transportation system.

Taxi service is also available through private companies.



The City of Maysville has operated under the city manager form of government as put forth by Kentucky Revised Statute 83.160 since 1958. The City Manager is the chief executive officer of the City of Maysville, and this position is appointed by the Board of Commissioners for an indefinite term. It has a five member Board of Commissioners, including the Mayor, which sets policies through municipal orders, resolutions and ordinances.

Mason County operates under a commission form of government. The County is divided into three districts and commissioners, who, although elected at large, represent their respective district. Under KRS 67.710, the County Judge/Executive is the chief executive officer of the county and presides over Fiscal Court.

Created through an inter-local cooperative agreement between the City of Maysville and Mason County in 1985, the Maysville-Mason **County Industrial Development Authority's** (MMCIDA) purpose is to serve as the economic development and marketing agency for Maysville and Mason County. The Authority promotes the Maysville-Mason County area nationally and internationally as the preeminent community for new and expanding business entities. As the primary organization responsible for industrial and economic development within Maysville-Mason County, MMCIDA helps expand commerce and industry in the region through the development of four publicly owned industrial parks and a variety of financing mechanisms to assist the location and/ or expansion of industry within Mason County.

Additionally, MMCIDA works with several allied partners locally and regionally on community-wide economic and workforce development initiatives such as e-connectivity, infrastructure and labor supply. Ultimately, MMCIDA's two main goals are to create diverse, high-paying, self-sustaining jobs and to expand the tax base of local government. Maysville/Mason County currently has four industrial parks throughout the county with several shovel ready sites and existing available buildings. Enjoy new release movies at the recently rennovated Lucas Cinema 4, or live entertainment at the **Washington Opera House**, home of local theater group, the Maysville Players. Their 2018-19 season includes Mother Hicks, The Best Christmas Pageant Ever: The Musical, Doubt, Fools, and Music Man (Jr.). Another jewel is the **Russell Theatre**, an atmospheric theatre listed on the National Register of Historic Places. 


THINGS TO DO

The Historic Bourbon Displays at the Old Pogue Experience

The Kentucky Gateway Museum Center recently began a partnership with the Pogue family to assist with the permanent gallery to display the historic story of Maysville's role in the formation of the bourbon industry. The bourbon history exhibits are housed in the Kentucky Gateway Museum Center's Limestone Building at the corner of Second and Sutton Streets in downtown Maysville. These exhibits are dictated to telling the Old Pogue story and will become the starting place for visitors that are coming to Maysville to participate in the B-Line and Craft Bourbon Tour experiences.

The Kentucky Gateway Museum Center, in partnership with the Pogue family, along with local collectors and Museum's bourbon collection highlight Maysville's bourbon history. The displays and exhibit feature the historical background of Maysville (formerly known as Limestone) as the place where bourbon began its journey to the rest of the country by way of the Ohio River and the Maysville Road (now U.S. 68).

The bourbon exhibits showcased in the KYGMC's Limestone Building tell the story of Maysville's historic bourbon heritage to area residents and visitors. In addition to artifacts from Old Pogue Distillery, there are other priceless artifacts like Maysville stoneware jugs, advertising pieces, and documents. These items take visitors from the early days of arriving at Limestone in 1784 to modern day bourbon production at the Old Pogue Distillery in Maysville.




